MEETING PRESENTATION: Jimmy Black - Medicinal Xerophytes of Texas: Pharmacology vs. Folklore.

This talk will center on xerophytes of Texas with a focus on Chihuahuan Desert plants. My intent is to identify those plants that have reported or claimed medicinal benefits in humans. I will discuss basic physiology and pharmacology specific to understanding why and how these plants may (or may not) have the medicinal effects often associated with them. While dealing with highly technical concepts, the presentation itself should be easy to understand and not require any prior knowledge of medicine, pharmacology, or human physiology.

Jimmy developed his love of cactus when he helped his mom work with succulents at the age of 12, He built his first dish garden at that age. Since then he has, along with his wife Ann, established and out-of-control hobby focused on the propagation and care of succulents from all over the world. Jimmy has a particular affection for cactus of the Southwest and specifically the Chihuahuan desert. He and his wife have been members of the San Antonio Cactus and Xerophyte Society since 2003. He is also an Associate Member of TACSS and a member of CSSA.

Jimmy worked in healthcare up until his retirement in January of 2019. He completed his undergraduate degree in Pharmacy (BS) at The University of Texas at



Austin and became a licensed (Registered) pharmacist. He went on to complete his doctorate training at the UT Health Science Center at San Antonio and a clinical residency in Adult Medicine at Breckenridge Hospital in Austin, TX. His 33 year work career focused mainly on the Medical Affairs aspect of Research and Development in the pharmaceutical industry. He had the privilege of working on 13 individual compounds that gained FDA approval and eventually were introduced in the United States including atorvastatin (Lipitor), gabapentin (Neurontin), and exenatide (Byetta). He has over 40 referred publications and has spoken nationally and internationally on topics specific to the compounds on which he worked.
