

LONG BEACH CACTUS CLUB

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

Section 1. The name of this organization shall be THE LONG BEACH CACTUS CLUB hereinafter called the CLUB.

ARTICLE 2 - PURPOSE

Section 1. The purposes for which this Club is formed are the following:

(a) To stimulate interest in the conservation, and to promote the culture and development of cacti and succulents.

(b) To acquire and disseminate information regarding these plants, and to encourage their protection and propagation.

(c) To give exhibitions when deemed suitable and proper and to present programs to the members and their guests.

(d) To do everything suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any one or more of the purposes herein enumerated, or conducive to or expedient for the interest or benefit of this Club.

ARTICLE 3 - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. The kinds, classes and fees for membership shall be fixed in accordance with the conditions imposed by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE 4 - OFFICERS - DIRECTORS

Section 1. The kinds, duties and tenure of office shall be fixed in accordance with the conditions imposed in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE 5 - AMENDMENTS

Section 1. The Constitution may be amended at any time by a two-thirds vote of the members present at any meeting, provided the proposed amendment has been read at two previous meetings.

ARTICLE 6 - AUTHORITY

Section 1. Robert's Rules of Order shall govern all points not covered in this Constitution and By-Laws.
