TRIP TO CHILE

PROGRAM: **JOE CLEMENTS** will present a PowerPoint presentation about his trip to Chile last October with a group from CSSA. The country will be covered from the desert in the north to Santiago to the Chilean Alps in the south. A geologist by training, Joe has long been one of the leading figures in the Southern California cactus and succulent scene. About five years ago he retired from his post as Director of the Huntington Desert Garden after a tenure of over twenty-two years. He is currently Director of the Arboretum at Pitzer College.

LOCATION: **Dominguez Rancho Adobe**, 18127 South Alameda Street, Rancho Dominguez, CA 90220. Take the 91 Redondo Beach/ Artesia Freeway and exit south on Alameda. Signs for the Adobe are posted on the freeway and on Alameda. Coming from the freeway, the entrance to the Adobe is on the right or west side of Alameda. The meeting will be in the **Carriage House** which is at the south end of the Dominguez Rancho Adobe Museum. It is at your right as you turn off the entry road into the parking area.

TIME: **Sunday, November 20, 2005 at 1:30 p.m.** We will follow this schedule: 1:30 to 2:00 -- setup and refreshments, 2:00 to 4:00 -- general meeting and program, 4:00 to 4:30 -- cleanup.

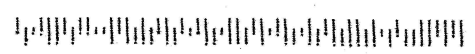

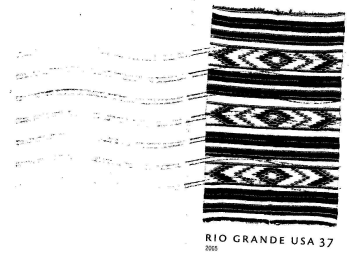
