

Remember, if you are bringing in items for auction, we need you to try and get them there by 12:30 or 12:45 at the latest. We will need volunteers to arrange auction items at the silent auction tables. I don't know how many plants will be up for the silent auction but if there is a total of 30 items or less, all items will be auctioned off in the live auction. There have been offers to donate all proceeds of certain items to the club. Thank you to those who have decided to do that. For those of you that are not donating but are offering items for sale, thank you too. The breakdown is 70 / 30, you will be sent one check for 70% of the total that your items sell for. Please make sure we have a good address for you on file.

We still need volunteers for small things and would appreciate any help. No volunteer positions require any expertise in plants.

Hope to see many of you at the auction with (an) item(s) for the auction.

We will not be using the snack schedule this time so, if you can, please bring snacks to share.
