DIRECTIONS

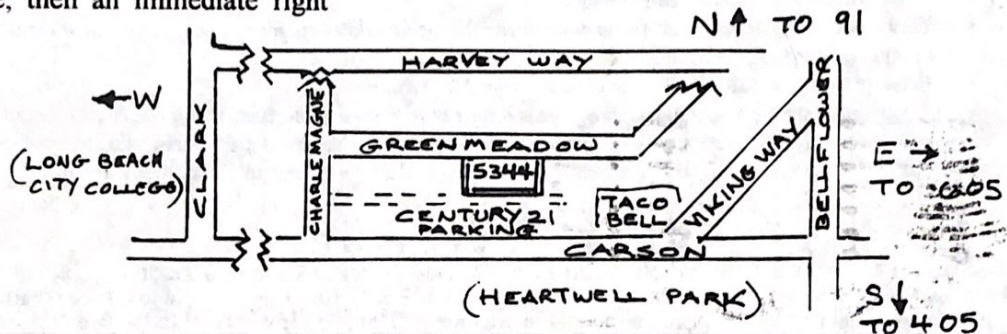
From the 405: Exit on Bellflower northbound, go to Carson, turn left, go to Charlemagne, turn right, then an immediate right onto Greenmeadow.

From the 91: Exit on Bellflower southbound, go to Carson, turn right on Carson, turn right on Charlemagne, then an immediate right onto Greenmeadow.

From the 605: Exit at Carson westbound, turn right on Charlemagne, then an immediate right onto Greenmeadow.

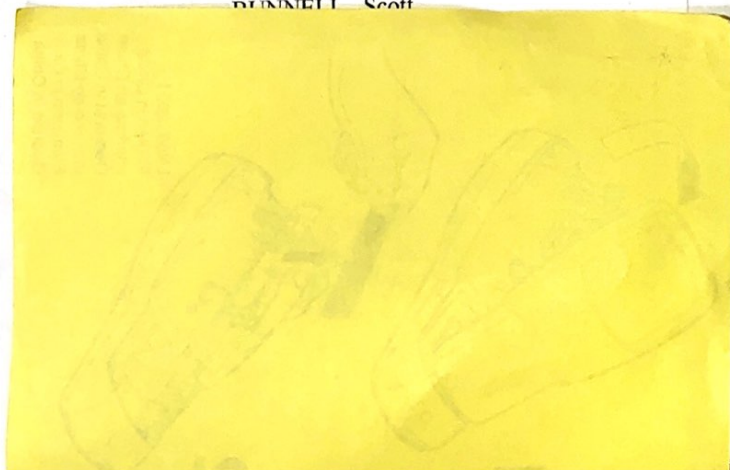
