CACTI OF NORTHERN MEXICO

PROGRAM: RENE AND PATTY CARO will present a slide lecture on their recent trip to northern Mexico. They visited the San Luis Potosi/Tamaulipas area in October, 1999 with Woody Minnich. We will see in habitat views of Ariocarpus, Astrophytum, Aztekium, Geohintonia and Obregonia.

Rene and Patty have been growing cacti and succulents for about four and a half years. After buying their first plants at Home Depot, they went to the CSSA show at the Huntington where they met Joe Clements, director of the Desert Garden. Subsequently, they joined the San Gabriel Valley C&SS and have been enthusiastically pursuing the hobby and participating in shows and events ever since. We welcome them to our roster of speakers.

2000 PLANT-OF-THE-MONTH RULES

At the November, 1996 meeting, the following rules were adopted for the Plant-of the-Month (POM) competition:

A maximum of three plants may be entered in each category (cactus and succulent). There will be three classes for entrants: advanced, intermediate and beginner.

Advanced and intermediate entrants must have had the plant in their possession for at least six months, beginners for three months.

Entrants will receive 6 points for first place, 4 points for second place, 2 points for third place and 1 point for showing a plant that does not place.
At the discretion of the judges there may be up to three third places in a category. If plants are

not deemed to be of sufficient quality, no third place will be awarded.

For an entrant to receive points, the entry tags must be collected by the person in charge of record keeping for POM.

At the annual Christmas party, award plants will be presented to the ten highest cumulative point holders regardless of class.


