### ANNUAL PLANT AUCTION

LOCATION: Dominguez Adobe, 18127 South Alameda Street, Compton, CA 90221. Take the 91 Redondo Beach / Artesia Freeway and exit south on Alameda. Signs for the Adobe are posted on the freeway and on Alameda. Coming from the freeway, the entrance to the Adobe is on the right or west side of Alameda. DO NOT BE FAZED BY DETOUR AND ROAD CLOSURE SIGNS. THERE IS ONLY ONE EN-TRANCE TO THE ADOBE AND IT IS ACCESSIBLE ALTHOUGH THE ROAD IS PARTLY UN-PAVED. 

Recognized as a very quiet, kind man by those who knew him, Larry was best known to many of us for bringing alive plant pioneers past and present in many illuminating profiles which appeared in the Cactus and Succulent Journal. He was Professor Emeritus of Weed Science at UC Davis. Although retired, he came to his office almost every day where he was found leaning back in his chair as if taking a rest from his writing.


